Project Title/Instructional Focus: Paper Folded Sculpture

**Grade Level:** K-1 Time to Complete Project: 2 days

Type of Instruction: Skill Based

#### Medium(s) Used:

- 11 by 18 paper for base
- Colored paper strips
- Glue Sticks

#### **Student Learning Objectives:**

- 1. Students can demonstrate folding paper in different styles throughout class.
- 2. Students will classify the lines they see in their sculpture in small groups at the end of class.
- 3. Students will produce a paper sculpture by the end of class.

## **Knowledge for this lesson/Vocabulary: :**

- Intro to Line
- Folding terms
  - zig zag
  - Accordion
  - Swirl
  - Curly Cue

#### Resources:

- Fold demo/sample board
- Example of finished project

## **Activity/Procedure**

- Start the day by showing the fold sample board and have the students use their bodies to act like each kind of fold.
- Have everyone grab 6 strips of paper for practicing/learning the folds
- One by one, using the doc camera, have students follow the step by step process for each fold
- check for understanding by having students raise their hands above their head when feeling confident in all folds
- If students are struggling ask table partners to assist them in the process
- Write on the board these simple steps
  - Grab large piece of paper
  - Only 3 strips at a time
  - Glue stick
  - NAME
- Ask students to read them if they can and start selecting quiet students to gather materials and work on project
- 10 min before class is done table partners should collaborate on lines they see in their sculptures, and we will have a classification discussion.
- Classroom cleanup procedures 5 min prior to class, exit ticket of handing in their sculptures!
